Sherry J. Davis is the Director of Environmental Safety and Occupational Health for the Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA). Ms. Davis' primary responsibility is providing a safe and healthful environment for all of DTRA employees both inside and outside the Continental United States. She provides Agency-wide leadership and guidance on environmental, radiation, safety, industrial hygiene, and occupational health support.

Ms. Davis joined DTRA in 2004 as a Safety Manager assisting the office chief in developing and managing safety programs. She later served as Deputy Chief, Environment, Safety, and Occupational Health before assuming her current position.

A native of Memphis, Tennessee, Ms. Davis served honorably in the United States Air Force and retired after 26 years. During her military career, she served mostly in staff positions at the base, major command, and headquarters levels as the advisor and consultant to senior leaders on safety concerns. Most notable are her rotations to Operation DESERT SHIELD/DESERT STORM; Prince Sultan Air Base, Saudi Arabia; and Joint Special Operations Task Force, Brindisi Airfield, Italy. Her assignments included Lackland Air Force Base, Texas; Offutt Air Force Base, Nebraska; Okinawa Air Base, Japan; Lowry Air Force Base, Colorado; Myrtle Beach Air Force Base, South Carolina; Pease Air Force Base, New Hampshire; Kunsan Air Base, Korea; Altus Air Force Base, Oklahoma; Royal Air Force Mildenhall, United Kingdom (twice); Holloman Air Force Base, New Mexico; San Vito Air Station, Italy; Moron Air Base, Spain; and Kirtland Air Force Base, New Mexico. Ms. Davis concluded her military career serving as the Superintendent of Ground Safety for the Air Force at the Air Force Safety Center, Kirtland Air Force Base.

Ms. Davis has Bachelor of Science in Management/Human Resources from Park University in Parkville, Missouri, and a Master of Science in Organizational Behavior from the University of Phoenix in Arizona.

Ms. Davis has numerous military and DoD civilian awards, including two DTRA Special Act Awards.
