


**FISCAL YEAR 2011 REPORT OF CLOSED MEETING OF
THE THREAT REDUCTION ADVISORY COMMITTEE
UNDER SECTION 10(d) OF THE FEDERAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE ACT**

The Threat Reduction Advisory Committee met in closed plenary session on November 22, 2010 at the Heritage Conference Center, Chantilly, Virginia.

The meeting was conducted in closed session because it concerned matters listed in 5 U.S.C. 552B(c)(1)(1988). Full development of the topics required discussion of information classified at the Top Secret and Secret levels. Classified and unclassified issues were so intertwined that they could not reasonably be separated without defeating the effectiveness and meaning of the overall meeting. As the TRAC Chairman, I presided over the May meeting. The Committee considers threat reduction strategies and implementation, global threat reduction prototypes, biological defense, nuclear security and weapons of mass destruction (WMD) threats. These national security issues relate to the scientific and technical aspects of overall threat reduction.

The committee received an annual ethics training briefing from Mr. Jeffery Green of the Department of Defense Office of General Counsel (OGC). The committee also received briefings from Ms. Marcia LoVerdi, Mr. Peter Birmingham, and Mr. Steven Lollis, all of the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA), on Countering Weapons of Mass Destruction (CWMD). Mr. Jeff Subko, Chief, Governmental and Public Affairs, Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA) provided an overview of DTRA and the U.S. Strategic Command Center for Combating Weapons of Mass Destruction (SCC-WMD) and Mr. Kenneth Meyers, Director, DTRA, provided a status of current Cooperative Threat Reduction (CTR) programs. Additionally, the committee received a briefing from Mr. William O'Donnell, Associate Director, Strategy and Plans Enterprise, DTRA, on the potential focus of the committee as indicated by a survey of the membership, and participated in a discussion about the mission of the committee and the information needed by the Under Secretary hosted by Mr. Andrew Weber, Assistant to the Secretary of Defense for Nuclear and Chemical and Biological Defense Programs (NCB).
