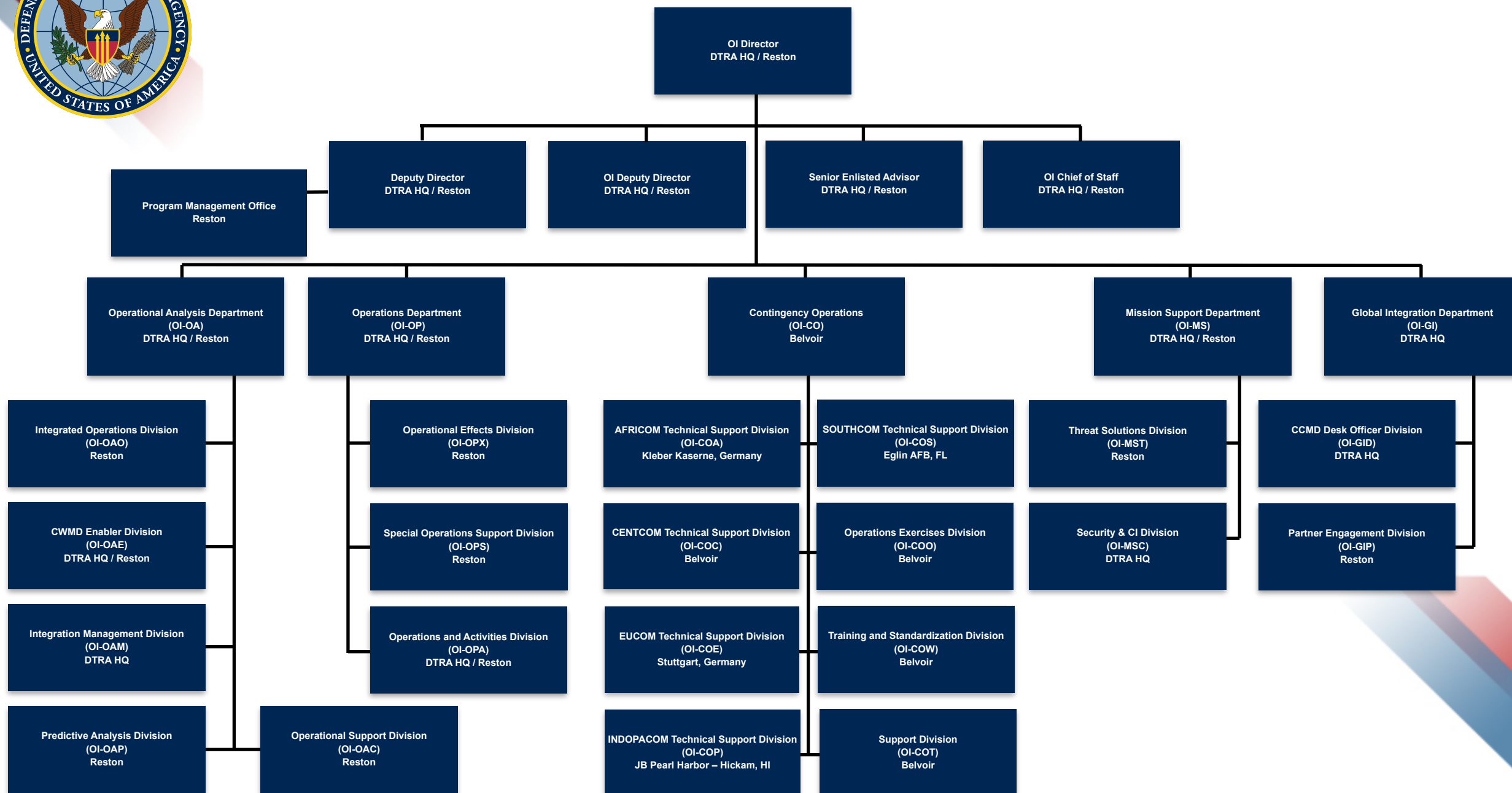

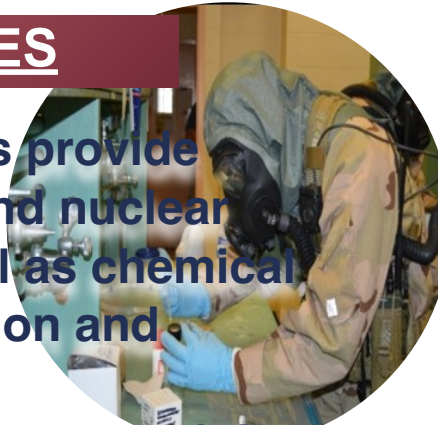


Contingency Support (OI-CO)

Mission Priority: The Contingency Operations Department enables designated joint and combined forces to conduct mission-tailored reconnaissance to locate, identify, and characterize Weapons of Mass Destruction and Chemical, Biological, Radiological, and Nuclear threats across the competition continuum in support of the Combatant Commander.

CORE CAPABILITIES

- Technical support groups provide support to radiological and nuclear search operations as well as chemical and biological identification and characterization
- Plans, develops, and executes training support for Special Operations Forces to execute their CWMD mission
- Tests and fields specialized equipment to fill gaps and integrate into a common operating picture



OPERATIONAL OUTCOME

- Enable response forces to search for, detect, and identify WMD/CBRN threats

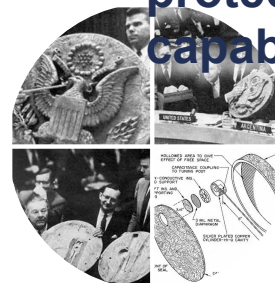
