Mr. Craig G. Miller, a member of the Senior Executive Service (SES), is the General Counsel for the Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA). As the chief legal officer and counselor to the director, he provides both legal and policy advice on all aspects of agency operations.

Mr. Miller retired as a Colonel in the U.S. Air Force in 2015 after almost 27 years on active duty as a judge advocate. Among his positions in the Air Force JAG Corps, he served as Senior Military Assistant to the Department of Defense General Counsel, as Director of Air Force Operations and International Law Directorate on Air Staff, and as a Staff Judge Advocate three times including at the Ogden Air Logistics Center, Hill Air Force Base, Utah (Air Force Material Command); the 21st Space Wing, Peterson Air Force Base, Colorado (Air Force Space Command); and the 497th Combat Training Squadron, Paya Lebar Air Base, Singapore (Pacific Air Forces). He also served as Chief of the Operations Law Branch in HQ USAF, focusing on matters such as the Law of Armed Conflict, contractors on the battlefield, and treatment of detainees and interrogation.

Earlier in his Air Force career he served at the wing level at Pease Air Force Base, New Hampshire, as Circuit Trial Council in the Eastern Judicial Circuit, as a Medical Law Consultant at Wilford Hall Medical Center, Lackland Air Force Base, Texas, and in the General Law Division, HQ Air Force Material Command, Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, Ohio.

Mr. Miller earned a Master of Laws in International and Comparative Law from George Washington University School of Law in Washington, D.C., a Juris Doctorate from Mississippi College School of Law in Jackson, and a Bachelor of Arts in History and a Master of Science in Educational Administration from Bob Jones University in Greenville, South Carolina. He is a member in good standing of the District of Columbia Bar, the State of Mississippi Bar, and the Bars of various Courts of Appeals and of the Supreme Court of the United States. Mr. Miller has many major awards and decorations, including the Defense Superior Service Medal, Legion of Merit, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal with five oak leaf clusters, Air Force Commendation Medal with one oak leaf cluster, Joint Meritorious Unit Award, Air Force Outstanding Unit Award with five oak leaf clusters, Air Force Organizational Excellence Award, National Defense Service Medal with one oak leaf cluster, and the Global War on Terrorism Service Medal.
