David L. Musgrave is a member of the Department of Defense (DoD) Senior Executive Service (SES) and possess broad expertise in National Security Strategy and Policy, International Affairs/Relations, International Security Assistance/Cooperation, Defense Industrial Base manufacturing and Critical Infrastructure security and operations.

He currently serves as the Director, On-Site Inspection and Building Capacity Directorate, Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA). As Director, Mr. Musgrave directs the planning and implementation of United States arms control activities under numerous multilateral treaties and agreements; to include the bilateral nuclear arms control treaty with Russia. In partnership with the U.S. Interagency, multiple national and international organizations; he administers three international security cooperation and building partner capacity portfolios operating across five geographic combatant command areas of responsibility. Additionally, Mr. Musgrave plays an instrumental role in the professional development and talent management of the agency's workforce and served as the senior champion of DTRA's mentoring program and is the Co-Chair of the Diversity, Equity and Inclusion Council.

Mr. Musgrave is a retired U.S. Army Colonel and was appointed as a member of the Senior Executive Service immediately upon retirement. During his military career he served as the Chief of the Countering Weapons of Mass Destruction (CWMD), the Joint Chiefs of Staff (J5); Commanding Officer Pine Bluff Arsenal in Pine Bluff, Arkansas; Aide-de-Camp/Advisor to the Commanding General United States Forces - Iraq (Operation New Dawn); Commanding Officer of the Bluegrass Chemical Activity in Richmond, Kentucky and several other staff and command positions.

Mr. Musgrave holds a Master of Science Degree from the Eisenhower School, National Defense University; a Master of Arts from the Naval War College; a Bachelor of Science from Middle Tennessee State University; and is a graduate of the Senior Executives in National and International Security program from the Harvard Kennedy School of Executive Education. His awards include the Defense Superior Service Medal with oak leaf cluster, the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star with oak leaf cluster and numerous other awards and decorations.
