The Defense Threat Reduction Information Analysis Center is the key source for information and analysis of DTRA mission area topics. DTRIAC collects and maintains extensive databases of historical and technical data and performs retrieval, organization, analysis, publication, and distribution of archived information in response to customers' needs. DTRIAC also provides state-of-the-art technical information acquisitions and analysis to support DTRA mission areas through both technical staff and partners consisting of consultants and subcontractors.

DTRIAC is one of the oldest DoD Information Analysis Centers (IACs) and is located in Albuquerque, New Mexico on Kirtland AFB. We also have a satellite annex, the STI Support Center, serving the NCR located at the DTRA, Fort Belvoir, Virginia.

## Mission

- Provide support to DTRA, the military services, other Department of Defense and government agencies in all threat reduction areas.

## Focus

The DTRIAC is the Threat Reduction and CWMD Communities' portal for Scientific and Technical (S&T) information through core activities and Task Orders.

### **DTRIAC Core Activities**

- Maintain and archive more than two million cataloged documents, films, stills, drawings, and engineering data, making it the largest IAC collection in DoD.
- Provide technical inquiry services.

### **DTRIAC Task Orders (TOs)**

- Provide timely support to IAC customers who require specialized efforts on topics of very narrow technical focus and applicability, and require greater depth and specialization than is available as part of the core activities.
- TOs include studies, analyses, assembly of data collections, and development of tools and techniques for the collection and analysis of data, as well as other unique scientific and technical activities.
- Separately funded by the customer.

- Provide access to DTRA's technical knowledge preservation system: Scientific and Technical Information Archival and Retrieval System (STARS).
- Provide In-Depth Analysis: Technical Reports (TRs), Handbooks, Sourcebooks, Journals, and documentation.
