He provided oversight of the execution of exercises, assessments, requirements and deployment readiness management of the Agency's personnel to successfully employ Joint forces to support the Countering Weapons of Mass Destruction (CWMD operations while ensuring effective liaison with the Combatant Commands and key Interagency partners.

With over 40 years of cumulative service in DoD, Mr. Cooper has served in a myriad of positions throughout the United States, Europe, Korea and Southwest Asia that ranges from section level to echelons above Corps. During his thirty years of service in the US Army. Don has a proven background in leading, training, planning and executing at the tactical, operational and strategic levels. Additionally, he has an equally wide-ranging background in CWMD operations and program management within DTRA.

Following his retirement from the service, Mr. Cooper served as the Chief of the Integration and Training Branch; Research and Development, Technical Reach-back Division; Chief of the Agency's Director's Action Group; Chief of the Joint Operations Center/Operations Division; Chief of the Mission Readiness Department and Director of the Combat Support Directorate until his reassignment into his current position.
