COL Christine V. Enriquez, is a U.S. Army Adjutant General (AG) Corps Officer, and serves as the Director of Human Resources. As the Human Resources Director, she ensures the Directorate operates as a collaborative and strategic partner to acquire, develop, and sustain a highly competitive and diverse workforce that possesses critical skillsets supporting the mission, vision, and values of DTRA.

COL Enriquez was born in Keflavik, Iceland and raised as a Navy dependent. She completed her Bachelor of Arts Degree in Writing Journalism and Master of Arts Degree in Organizational Management. She received her commission as an AG Officer in June 1996.

COL Enriquez' awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal, Meritorious Service Medal with six Oak Leaf Clusters, Army Commendation Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters, the Army Achievement Medal with seven Oak Leaf Clusters, the Parachutist Badge and the DA Staff Identification Badge. She is a recipient of the Adjutant General's Corps Regimental Association Lifetime Achievement Award and the Horatio Gates Gold and Bronze Medals.

Prior to her assignment as the DTRA HR Director, she served as the Chief, Force Sustainment Division, U.S. Army Human Resources Command (HRC) at Fort Knox, KY. During her tenure at HRC, she also served as the Executive Officer to the HRC Commanding General and Chief of Readiness in The Adjutant General (TAG) Directorate.

As a lieutenant colonel, COL Enriquez completed her Centralized Selection List (CSL) Key Billet Assignment as the ACoS, G1 for the 4<sup>th</sup> Infantry Division and Fort Carson, CO. Prior to her CSL Key Billet, she served as the Army's Military Awards and Promotions Policy Integrator in the ASA (M&RA), Pentagon.

As a major, COL Enriquez served as the Brigade S1 and later the Brigade Executive Officer for the 10<sup>th</sup> Sustainment Brigade, 10<sup>th</sup> Mountain Division, Fort Drum, NY. She deployed to Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.
