U.S. Air Force Brigadier General Todd A. Fogle is the Deputy Director of the Operations and Integration Directorate (OI) for the Defense Threat Reduction Agency (DTRA). He supports the OI Director in overseeing all efforts of the directorate which is responsible for applying advanced information technology, threat network analysis and operational research analytics, operations and planning, interagency and partner coordination, and training support to enable the Department of Defense to counter weapons of mass destruction and improvised threats including their supporting facilitation networks.

Before coming to DTRA, General Fogle served as the Special Assistant and Executive Officer to the Commanding General, USSOCOM, MacDill Air Force Base, Florida, and before that as the Commander of the 492d Special Operations Wing (SOW) located at Hurlburt Field. He is a Master Navigator with over 2,700 flight hours with a wide variety of flying and staff assignments including seven deployments supporting OIF, OEF, and OUP. He has commanded at the squadron, group, Joint Special Operations Air Component, Expeditionary SOW, and Wing levels. Previous joint assignments include Commander, Joint Special Operations Air Component-Africa and 27th Expeditionary Special Operations Wing-Africa in Kelley Barracks Germany; ISAF Senior Advisor to the Presidential Palace, Kabul, Afghanistan; Deputy Director Air Requirements Branch US USSOCOM, MacDill AFB; and Executive Officer to the Chief of Staff, HQ USSOCOM, MacDill AFB.

General Fogle entered the Air Force through the Cedarville University Reserve Officer Training Corps in 1992 and has a Bachelors in Mathematics and Physics and a Masters in National Security Strategy Resourcing from the Industrial College of the Armed Forces. He is a graduate of the U.S. Army Command and General Staff College, the National Defense University, and the Joint Forces Staff College.

His awards and decorations include the Defense Superior Service Medal with oak leaf cluster, Legion of Merit with two oak leaf clusters, Distinguished Flying Cross with Valor Device, Bronze Star Medal, Defense Meritorious Service Medal, Meritorious Service Medal with two oak leaf clusters, Air Medal with six oak leaf clusters, and the Air Force Combat Action Medal.
